
Foreign, Commonwealth & Development Office Advice

Cowes

Fri 6th Aug 2021 - Sat 7th Aug 2021

Home to the oldest and biggest sailing regatta in the world and this special voyage visits Cowes during Cowes Week. A remarkable way to see world-class sailing action, with champion yachtsmen and sailing enthusiasts all taking to the water. The town also boasts a rich wealth of history and culture and you will have sufficient time to explore if you so wish.

Old Shanklin to Bonchurch – Half Day

Enjoy a panoramic overview of the Isle of Wight including a stop at Carisbrooke Castle.

Exploring the Isle of Wight by Vintage Car - Half Day

Travel through the most scenic areas of the Isle of Wight by classic vintage motors.



Dartmouth

Sunday 8th August 2021

Dartmouth sits on the banks of the picturesque River Dart with a rich maritime heritage. It is part of the stunning South Devon Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty which is wonderful for those wanting to explore the beautiful countryside.

Countryside Steam Train & The English Riviera – Half Day

Discover Devonshire with a walking tour of Dartmouth, cruising along the River Dart to Totnes and riding a traditional steam train through the rolling scenery of Kingswear.

Slapton Ley Nature Walk – Half Day

Enjoy a guided walk of one of the finest areas of the British coastline, Slapton Ley the largest natural lake in the south-west.

Buckfast Abbey & Medieval Totnes – Half Day

Visit the fascinating Buckfast Abbey and stroll through the charming market town of Totnes.

Falmouth

Monday 9th August 2021

A Cornwall town known for its natural harbour and pretty beaches. The National Maritime Museum has interactive galleries and a floatilla of modern boats. There is plenty to do with boat trips, cliff walking and cycling. Learn of Cornwall's own female Scarlet Pimpernell, Lady Mary Killigrew of Penryn, a late 1500's Nobel aristocrat by day and a ruthless pirate by night.

Hike the Lizard Peninsula – Full Day

Head off the beaten track to the stunningly beautiful Lizard Peninsula, designated an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty.

Discover St. Ives – Half Day

The romantic coastal scenery of St. Ives has lured generations of artists since the 1800s. With so much to see, upon arrival take a brief guided orientation walk before exploring independently.



St Mary's

Tuesday 10th August 2021


The Isles of Scilly's largest island and the gateway to the rest of the islands. Covering an area of little more than 6 square miles. Hugh Town is the central hub, with a cluster of shops, banks and eateries, whilst Old Town is the other "major" settlement, with a beautiful beach and nature reserve. The coastline features large stretches of deserted sandy beaches, dramatic rocky coves, beautiful walks and stunning seascapes.

Wildlife Cruise & St Martins Vineyard – Half Day

Journey around the raw and rugged eastern isles which is a haven for wildlife, then take a stroll through St Martin's Vineyard and savour the tastes of the local wines.

Exotic Tresco Abbey Gardens – Half Day

This sub-tropical 'botanical paradise' has been planted in the ruins of a Benedictine priory under the direction of Augustus Smith. Today the gardens are home to an impressive collection of 20,000 plant species heralding from as far as New Zealand.





Plymouth

Wednesday 11th August 2021

The ancient city of Plymouth is perhaps one of the best-known Maritime cities in the world. Its strategic positioning and large natural harbour make it a traditional stronghold for the Royal Navy and Royal Marines and historic evidence of their continuous presence is to be seen at every glance. Across the water of Plymouth Sound lies fortified Drake's Island guarding the approaches.

Historic Plymouth – Half Day

Explore one of the best-known Maritime cities in the world with a local guide.

Dartmoor National Park & Lydford Gorge – Half Day

Travel through rolling countryside to the beautiful Dartmoor National Park and capture the Lydford Gorge, a National treasure. Enjoy an enchanting walk through the steeply sided ravine, scooped out by the River Lyd as it plunges into a series of whirlpools, including the thrilling Devil's Cauldron.

Scenic Dartmoor – Half Day

Enjoy a panoramic overview of Dartmoor National Park's famous wide-open moors, wooded valleys, rushing rivers and wildlife and its scenery is dominated by its rugged tors, outcrops of granite formed around 280 million years ago.



Poole

Thursday 12th August 2021

The Old Town has Georgian houses and Poole Museum, which explores local history. From Poole Harbour, boats head south to Brownsea Island. This wooded area has trails and wildlife such as red squirrels, plus 16th-century Brownsea Castle, now a private hotel.

RSPB Nature Walk – Half Day

Join your RSPB Arne guide for a guided walk, keeping your eyes peeled for wildlife and enjoying the beautiful landscape.

Mystical Stonehenge – Half Day

Enjoy an awe-inspiring visit to the enigmatic Stonehenge – a World Heritage Site and the world's most famous stone circle which remains a mystery.
