
Foreign, Commonwealth & Development Office Advice

Portrush

Friday 23rd July 2021

A small seaside resort town on the north coast of County Antrim, Northern Ireland. It has grown from a charming fishing village into a top-rated holiday destination. Part of the old town is built on a mile-long peninsula, Ramore Head, which sticks out into the Atlantic Ocean. Relax on blue flag beaches, spend pennies in the arcades, try some of the tasty food in one of the local restaurants or just a short drive along the coast road discover the renowned Giants Causeway.

Giants Causeway – Half Day

A UNESCO World Heritage Site, discover the 40,000 massive black basalt columns which rise from the sea, with time to explore the visitor centre.

Delightful Londonderry – Half Day

With its history revered and its charm and vivacity still intact after “the Troubles”, Londonderry makes for a really interesting visit. Walk along the city walls and stop in a local establishment to enjoy a glass of wine or beer.

Bushmills Distillery – Half Day

The world’s oldest licenses whiskey distillery has continuously produced whiskey for almost 400 years. Discover the secrets of crafting the renowned whiskey and enjoy a semi tutored tasting whilst relaxing at the 1608 bar.

Whiskey on the Rocks – Half Day

Take your first steps on to the Giants Causeway with a guide that will bring this ancient place to life. Next is the whiskey, a Busmills Whiskey expert will explain the history and the methods used whilst your reserve is poured.



Belfast

Saturday 24th July 2021

Northern Ireland’s capital, and the birthplace of RMS Titanic. Originally named “Beal Feirste” – Gaelic for “mouth of the sandy fjord” – Belfast was founded in the 17th century and prospered in the industrial age, becoming famous for its shipyards and linens. The city has seen decades of political strife but has rebounded and now boasts a vibrant waterfront district and lively pub scene. Explore Belfast’s Maritime Heritage with Titanic Belfast and the Titanic Memorial Garden. Top sights include the stately Grand Opera House, the Albert Memorial Clock Tower and the Queen’s University.

Belfast by Bike – Half Day

Discover Belfast on a leisurely cycle route through the city centre.

Rhythm & Tales of Belfast – Half Day

Journey through the streets of Belfast city and learn about the turbulent history, before enjoying an enchanting storytelling show with a chance to try your hand at Irish dancing, local melodies and street songs.

Titanic Belfast & Crumlin Road Gaol – Full Day

A panoramic drive through beautiful Belfast, an adventure-filled full day introducing the city’s captivating history and maritime traditions.
