
Foreign, Commonwealth & Development Office Advice

Tobermory

Friday 16th July 2021

Is the capital of the Isle of Mull and sits on the east coast of Mishnish, the most northerly part of the island. Built as a fishing port in 1788, this sheltered bay is home to colourful houses, eateries, shops and plenty of locally produced arts and crafts.

Sealife Adventure – Half Day

Set off on a trip around the water of Mull and enjoy the company of an experienced wildlife team. Be on the look-out for birds of prey, minke whales, basking sharks and sea dolphins.

Glengorm Castle Walk – Half Day

An exquisite 19th Century country house stands alone on the headland of Glengorm. Enjoy a 2-hour walking tour uncovering the history of the area.

Duart Castle – Half Day

Standing proudly on a cliff top guarding the Sound of Mull, the castle enjoys one of the most spectacular positions on the west coast of Scotland.

Stornoway

Saturday 17th July 2021

Originally a Viking settlement, Stornoway is the main town on the island of Lewis in the Outer Hebrides. This bustling harbour town is home to Lews Castle and handcrafted goods from the Outer Hebrides including Harris Tweed.

Lews Castle Walk – Half Day

Hear the fascinating local stories and learn about Stornoway's rich history with a walk to Lews Castle, stopping at various points of interest along the way.



Harris Tweed Workshop – Half Day

Discover the 'Story of the Harris Tweed' and with an experienced seamstress enjoy a workshop learning how to create a beautiful piece from Harris Tweed.

Stornoway by RIB – Half Day

A RIB trip around the water of the stunning, unspoilt Uig Atlantic Coast, rich in wildlife including seals, seabirds, minke whales and birds of prey.

Scenic Harris – Half Day

Wonderfully scenic and mountainous roads to the southern Isle of Harris and the busy little port town of Tarbert before continuing south west to enjoy some free time on the spectacular Horgasbost beach.

Ullapool

Sunday 18th July 2021

Nestled on the shores of Lochbroom is the picturesque town of Ullapool. Despite its small size it is the largest settlement for many miles around and an important port and tourist destination. With a strong fishing heritage and surrounded by rugged mountains this is an ideal base for exploring the local landscapes: from Corrieshalloch Gorge to the wild and remote highland landscapes of the Geopark

Nature Reserve and Waterfalls – Half Day

A steep 30-minute walk to stunning waterfalls then a scenic drive on to Dundonnell Forest and a stop at the picturesque Gruinard Bay.

Knockan Crag – Hiking in the Heart of the Geopark – Half Day

One of Scotland's natural beauties and a must for hiking lovers.





Portree

Monday 19th July 2021

This main town on the Isle of Skye in the Inner Hebrides has a thriving cultural centre and is a popular base for exploring the rest of the island. Visitors are drawn to the spectacular scenery including the landscapes that surround Eilean Donan Castle and the dramatic Kilt Rock which looks strikingly similar to a pleated kilt.

Eilean Donan Castle – Half Day

Located on a little island where three sea lochs meet, in the midst of some of Scotland's most dramatic scenery.

Scorrybreac Walk & History of Portree – Half Day

Explore Portree, a bustling fishing town huddled around a charming harbour and continue the Scorrybreac route where you will be rewarded with some fantastic views to Raasay.



Port Ellen

Tuesday 20th July 2021

A small town on the island of Islay, in Argyll, Scotland. Arriving by ship it is impossible to miss the square shaped Carraig Fhada Lighthouse and its bay of golden sand. The island is best known for its whisky distilleries and you'll have the chance for a wee dram.

An Islay Distillery – Half Day

Probably best known for its malt whiskies and eight working distilleries, take a visit to one of the distilleries and of course an opportunity to sample a dram.

Centuries Old Finlaggan and the Wetlands – Half Day

Finlaggan is a beautiful and peaceful setting and Islay is an important location for migrating birds. Visit the RSPB reserve at Loch Gruinart and join a range for a guided walk through a variety of wetland habitats.
