
Foreign, Commonwealth & Development Office Advice

Weymouth Bay

Wednesday 23rd June 2021

Is a sheltered bay on the south coast of England in Dorset. The area has several beaches including Weymouth Beach which is overlooked by a Georgian seafront. There are plenty of quaint restaurants, cafes and craft shops to browse here.

Jurassic Coastal Walk – Half Day

Starting from the stunning natural arch of Durdle Door enjoy a guided walk along the coastal path to Lulworth Cove

Minterne House, Gardens & the Cerne Abbas Giant - Half Day

Journey through the Dorset countryside to Minterne House, which nestles in 1,300 acres of beautiful Dorset Countryside. There will also be the opportunity to capture the Cerne Abbas Giant or the 'Rude Man' which is one of the largest hill figures in Britain.



Falmouth

Thursday 24th June 2021

A town on the coast of Cornwall known for its deep natural harbour and pretty beaches. The National Maritime Museum has interactive galleries and a floatilla of modern boats. A start and finish point for a number of round the world record-breaking voyages. There is plenty to see and do with boat trips, cliff walking and cycling. Learn of Cornwall's own female Scarlet Pimpernell, Lady Mary Killigrew of Penryn, a late 1500's Nobel aristocrat by day and a ruthless pirate by night

Hike the Lizard Peninsula – Full Day

Head off the beaten track to the stunningly beautiful Lizard Peninsula, designated an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty.

Discover St. Ives – Half Day

The romantic coastal scenery of St. Ives has lured generations of artists since the 1800s. With so much to see, upon arrival take a brief guided orientation walk before exploring the town independently.

Fowey

Friday 25th June 2021

Is a small historical harbour town at the mouth of the River Fowey in south Cornwall. It is set in an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty and is brimming with cafes, pubs and restaurants and nearby National Trust attractions. It is also the starting point to excursions to the world-famous Eden project.

Fowey Coastal Hike – Half Day

Hike along the cliffs of the south west coast path capturing the beauty of the UK's coast.

Eden Project – Half Day

Explore the world's largest global garden, discovering the magic of this amazing project and the flora of the world.



Dartmouth

Saturday 26th June 2021

Dartmouth sits on the banks of the picturesque River Dart with a rich maritime heritage. It is part of the stunning South Devon Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty which is wonderful for those wanting to explore the beautiful countryside.

Countryside Steam Train & The English Riviera – Half Day

Discover Devonshire with a walking tour of Dartmouth, cruising along the River Dart to Totnes and riding a traditional steam train through the rolling scenery of Kingswear.

Slapton Ley Nature Walk – Half Day

Enjoy a guided walk of one of the finest areas of the British coastline, Slapton Ley the largest natural lake in the south-west.

Buckfast Abbey & Medieval Totnes – Half Day

Visit the fascinating Buckfast Abbey and stroll through the charming market town of Totnes.





Poole

Sunday 27th June 2021

The Old Town has Georgian houses and Poole Museum, which explores local history. From Poole Harbour, boats head south to Brownsea Island. This wooded area has trails and wildlife such as red squirrels, plus 16th-century Brownsea Castle, now a private hotel. The harbour is a drowned valley formed at the end of the last ice age and is the estuary of several rivers.

Mystical Stonehenge – Half Day

Enjoy an awe-inspiring visit to the enigmatic Stonehenge – a World Heritage Site and the world's most famous stone circle which remains a mystery.

RSPB Nature Walk – Half Day

Join your RSPB Arne guide for a guided walk, keeping your eyes peeled for wildlife and enjoying the beautiful landscape.
