

All excursion booking deadlines are available from Destination Services and will be highlighted in the Golden Horizon Daily Programme. Changes to shore excursion bookings are subject to our terms and conditions.

Should you wish to book excursions and Destination Services is closed there is a 'drop box' next to the counter where you are welcome to leave your completed and signed booking form. The team will process your booking form and deliver the tickets to your cabin.

Cancellation of Excursions

Port: St Tropez, France

Tuesday 24th May 2022

This coastal town has transformed from a simple fishing village to 'the' place to see and be seen. Follow in the footsteps of mid-century icons by enjoying a leisurely quay-front coffee, lounging on picture-perfect beaches or shopping in the town's très chic boutiques.

A St Tropez Walk

Port: St Tropez

Duration: 2 hours

Description:

Explore the heart of St Tropez on foot with a local guide. Starting with a walk along the pier passing by a famous café, Senequier. Head into the centre, seeing the Town Hall and the church of St Tropez. Stroll through the narrow streets, see charming squares before walking uphill to the top of the village for breath-taking views.

Excursion Notes: This excursion is all on foot, guests should wear flat and comfortable shoes. Guests can choose to walk back from the excursion independently at their own leisure, stay in town or return to the ship with the guide. If you wish to stay in town, it is the guest's responsibility to return to the ship in time for sailing.

Grimaud Explorer & Wine Tasting

Port: St Tropez
Tour Code: STP/B
Duration: 3 ½ hours

Description:

Grimaud, a Provençal village once owned by the Grimaldi family. The impressive ruins of a medieval castle dominate the narrow streets. Enjoy a walk with your guide uncovering the history and highlights of Grimaud. After, travel to a local vineyard to taste a variety of wines before returning to the ship.

Excursion Notes: There is approximately 1 ½ hours of walking over uneven ground, inclines and some steps. Comfortable shoes are recommended. Those under the age of 18 cannot participate in the wine tasting.

Cycling the French Riviera

Port: St Tropez

Duration: 3 ½ hours

Description:

Enjoy coastal views, idyllic beaches and a refreshing swim on this cycling excursion of the French Riviera. Cycle up to the pinewood covered peninsula of St Tropez towards Tahiti Beach. Escaping the crowds and traffic, explore St Tropez by bike, a sustainable way to capture the area.

Excursion Notes: The minimum age to participate on this excursion is 12 years old. Guests must be physically fit to participate and wear suitable footwear for cycling. Guests intending to swim should wear their swimsuits and bring a towel. Guests can choose between a bike and an e-bike, will be given helmets and gloves. A safety briefing will be provided. This is a small group excursion with very limited capacity.





Port: Antibes, France

Wednesday 25th May 2022

The pretty resort town of Antibes sits on the French Riviera with superyachts moored in the harbour. The old town, enclosed by 16th century ramparts is a great place to explore. Wander through alleys, admiring the decorative facades or enjoy a drink in one of the sun-soaked cafes. Antibes is home to the Picasso Museum a few steps away from the Provençal Market, where fruit and vegetable traders, fishmongers, butchers, and many more gather to sell their products.

Antibes Walk & Market Experience

Description:

Explore one of the oldest cities in France as you walk through the picturesque town with a local guide and taste some of the local delicacies. See the 16th century Grimaldi Château, stop at the Cours Massena and pass along the 17th century ramparts overlooking the Mediterranean Sea. After the excursion, browse the shops or relax in one of the many cafes before returning to the ship.

Excursion Notes: This excursion is all on foot, guests should wear flat and comfortable shoes. Guests can choose to stay in town at the end of the excursion, or after 45 minutes of free time the guide will be available to walk and escort guests back to the ship. Those who wish to stay in town must understand it is their responsibility to return to the ship in time for sailing.

The Stars of the Cote D'Azur

Port: Antibes

Description:

This excursion offers a full day of exploration along the famed French Riviera. Begin with a drive along the seacoast on route to Cannes. Stop at the elegant 'Croisette Avenue' and admire the famous hotels and shops of rue d'Antibes. Continue to Grasse, the birthplace of the French perfume industry. Visit a perfume factory and learn how the wonderful scents are created. After, journey along the Gorges du Loup canyon on the way to Saint Paul de Vence, the meeting place of artists and stars. Here you'll enjoy some free time to get some lunch before exploring on a guided walk. This 16th century walled village has retained much of its medieval appearance. Stroll through the narrow, cobblestone lanes and browse the wonderful boutiques and art galleries before returning to the ship in Antibes.

Excursion Notes: This excursion is not recommended for guests with walking difficulties. There is approximately 2 hours of walking and additional walking at the guest's discretion, over cobbled ground. Guests will be required to climb steps. There will be time at leisure for guests to get lunch, at own expense.





Port: Portofino, Italy

Thursday 26th May 2022

We'll visit pretty Portofino where vibrantly painted houses hug the harbourfront and a maze of streets work their way up the hill; don't miss the best views of the village from the 15th-Century Castello Brown.



Portofino Walk & Brown Castle

Discover Portofino's unspoiled charm, romantic land, seascapes, luxuriant villas and elegant boutiques. Uncover the history as you stroll through the narrow streets with your guide. Walk to the church of St. George visit Castle Brown where you can gaze over the Gulf of Rapallo and Portofino. Continue to the lighthouse at the far end of the promontory before returning to Portofino on foot. End your excursion with a relaxing glass of wine and local focaccia.

Excursion Notes: This excursion is all on foot, therefore guests should wear flat and comfortable shoes and be physically fit to participate. Please note there are many steps throughout. To use the public toilet facilities in Portofino guests will be required to pay a small fee, we recommend carrying some small change. Please note the castle can decide to suddenly close.

Hike to Santa Margherita

Port: Portofino

Description:

Leaving the pier with your guide, pass elegant shops and boutiques on route to Cappelletta. Walking mainly uphill, see elegant villas nestled amongst rich tropical vegetation and olive trees, eventually reaching Mulini. Continue through the Mediterranean vineyards until you arrive at the main promenade of Santa Margherita Ligure. Enjoy a light refreshment before you take your ferry ticket for your return to Portofino at your own leisure.

Excursion Notes: Majority of this excursion is on foot, over inclines and the ground may be slippery. This excursion is dependent on weather conditions, the guide may decide to change the route of the hike. Guests must be physically fit to participate on this excursion. Wear flat and comfortable shoes. Guests will be provided with a ferry ticket, and it is up to the guest which ferry to take back to the ship. It is at the guest's responsibility to return to the ship in time for sailing. The excursion duration of 3 hours and ends at Santa Margherita, the duration of the excursion does not include the return ferry time.





Port: Livorno, Italy

Friday 27th May 2022

The maritime city of Livorno, with its network of Venetian canals and fantastic seafood restaurants, is our next port of call and is the gateway to the spectacular scenery of Tuscany and many delightful vineyards. An opportunity to choose to visit some of the most iconic cities in Italy.

Pisa on your own

Explore one of Italy's most famous cities, Pisa. Enjoy a day at leisure discovering the famous sights. Make sure to visit the Field of Miracles where you can admire the world-famous Leaning Tower of Pisa and capture those memorable photos.

Excursion Notes: The coach transfer to Pisa is approximately 45 minutes. Walking is at the discretion of the guest; we recommend wearing flat and comfortable shoes. The experience leader on the bus will walk guests from the coach park to Miracle Square and advise of meeting times.



A Taste of Florence

Journey through beautiful Tuscan countryside to the city of Florence. With a local guide enjoy a walk of this magnificent city. At the end of the walk, there will be time at leisure to explore further. Find a lovely restaurant for lunch or just enjoy a wander before returning to Livorno.

Excursion Notes: Please note lunch is not included, but there will be time at leisure where guests can purchase lunch at their own expense. Wear flat and comfortable footwear. There is a strenuous amount of walking. The journey to and from Florence is approximately 1 ½ hours. The public toilet facilities in Florence require a small fee, therefore we recommend carrying some small change.



Tuscan Countryside and Wine Tasting

Description:

Travel through Tuscan countryside to the low surrounding hills, clad with olive groves, vineyards and neatly landscaped cypress trees. Enjoy some time to wander the quaint historic village of Montecarlo de Tuscany. After, travel to Buonamico Vineyards to sample two varieties of wine along with local salami and cheese. End with some time at leisure to explore the venue before returning to Livorno.

Excursion Notes: Guests under the age of 18 cannot participate in the wine tasting. Please wear flat and comfortable footwear.





Port: Porto Vecchio, Corsica, France

Sunday 29th May 2022

Porto Vecchio is a major economic and tourist hub in Corsica. The excellent position of the natural harbour attracted the Genoese who founded the town in 1539 as one of their defensive ports around the island. Nowadays, its appeal lies in a modern marina filled with impressive yachts, fishing boats, chic bars and restaurants. Its characterful old town is a jumble of streets and piazzas.

Introduction to Porto Vecchio

Description:

Explore this characterful settlement where you can get lost in a jumble of streets and piazzas. See the modern marina filled with yachts and fishing boats and walk along the ancient city walls passing the Porte Gènoise Gate. Here, you can capture a wonderful panoramic view of the harbour, the sea and the surrounding mountains. After your guided walk, enjoy a tasting of local products including hams, cheeses and wine before returning to the ship.

Excursion Notes: This excursion is all on foot, guests should wear flat and comfortable shoes.

Scenic Bavella



Description:

Impressive landscapes, distinctive spires and dramatic cliffs are to be expected on this excursion to the Bavella mountains. Leave the port and drive along the semi-coastal roads before starting your climb to the Bavella mountain and its needles. The views are breath-taking as you capture the surrounding landscapes of forests, rivers and granite boulders. Stop at Bavella pass, at an altitude of 1120 metres before travelling down via the village of Zonza, wild countryside and pass lake Ospedale before returning to the port.

Excursion Notes: There is approximately 800 metres of walking and uneven ground. Wear flat and comfortable shoes. Majority of this excursion is on the coach.

Terms & Conditions

WHAT'S INCLUDED

We have appointed the best local shore excursion agents and it is worth noting that the standards of transport vary considerably throughout the world, but our shore excursion agents provide us with the best available vehicles they have access to. The infrastructure varies considerably from country to country and sometimes coach standards may not match up to those at home.

Where organised excursions incorporate visits to museums, archaeological sites for example, the entrance fees are included in the cost of the excursions. Please note these visits can vary from guided to self-guided and time at leisure. On some excursions, where mentioned, refreshments or lunches may be included.

Where a set menu is stated in the excursion you will be asked in advance to confirm special dietary requirements with the team at Destination Services on board. It is important you do this as soon as possible and every effort will be made to fulfil these requirements.

LOCAL CURRENCY AND TIPPING ASHORE

You may like to take some local currency ashore for refreshments, public toilets and for souvenirs for instance. Local currencies are often available in the cruise terminals or at ATMs on shore. If you plan to use ATMs, please confirm with your bank before departure that your bank card and PIN will work abroad.

Although in some areas tipping is not customary you may still like to carry some local currency to show your appreciation when good service has been received, for example from your coach driver or local guide.

SHUTTLE BUSES

In ports where a shuttle bus is necessary our local agent will provide this service and it will be free of charge. The details of which will be provided by the on-board team at Destination Services and advertised within your daily programme.

DISEMBARKATION AND TIMINGS OF EXCURSIONS

All departure times and meeting points will be advised in the ship's daily programme and exact excursion departure times will be on your ticket. Some countries require you to carry certain documentation ashore and this is advised at the appropriate time. Once the ship has received clearance from the local authorities, you will be advised that you are able to disembark. Guests taking shore excursions will be escorted to their coaches or other modes of transport. Guests going ashore independently are free to disembark in their own time although we would respectfully ask them to allow excursion participants to disembark first, thus allowing them to maximise the excursion time in each port. In ports where our local shore excursion agents are able to offer both morning and afternoon excursions this will be clearly marked on the appropriate pages within this booklet or advertised once on board. Please keep in mind that departure times are subject to change. Time for lunch is scheduled but be aware if you are selecting two half day excursions that the time may be quite limited, especially if encountering a delay from return of a morning excursion.

ALL ABOARD

Excursions are scheduled by our local shore excursion agents taking all aboard timings into consideration.

DRESS AND FOOTWEAR

A comfortable pair of shoes is essential for sightseeing and a hat and sunscreen are also recommended. The climate in some countries can be unpredictable and we suggest layered clothing so you can add or remove as necessary. A waterproof coat and shoes are essential in the event of inclement weather. On excursions where entry to religious sites is included, we ask that you dress modestly. A simple code is to cover from shoulders to knees. Please be mindful that men in shorts and ladies in short skirts or shorts may not be allowed entry to some sites. For any excursions that involve swimming or a beach transfer, please bring a bathing costume. Pool towels will be provided by the ship. Further advice is given on board please check your daily programme of events.

FACILITIES

Wherever possible bathroom stops have been incorporated into the excursion itineraries and the best possible facilities available are suggested by our local shore excursion agents. Please be advised that standards may not always come up to those we are used to at home and in some countries, it is usual to make a nominal charge. Due to their size, some boats used by our local agents for excursions do not have provision for a toilet.

FITNESS

To assist you in selecting excursions appropriate to your physical limitations, we have indicated the amount of walking during certain excursions. Please bear in mind that all excursions with a site or museum visit will, by necessity, involve some walking and it may be necessary to walk a distance to and from the ship to the departure point for coaches/boat excursions. Information in the footnotes will reflect this. Please check with the

team at Destination Services on board if you have any concerns.

Regrettably, guests with limited mobility are unable to join the shore excursions unless able to board a standard coach unaided and are comfortable with the amount of walking stated.

LOST PROPERTY

Any property lost during an excursion must be reported to either Destination Services or Reception on board. Every effort will be made to trace the item; however, should this not be possible a report will be made noting the loss. Any claim arising from such losses should be directed to your insurer.

MEAL TIMES ON BOARD

When the ship is in port, meal times may be adjusted to suit the shore excursion timings and this will be advised as necessary on board.

PHOTOGRAPHY

In some venues the use of cameras, flash photography or video cameras is prohibited, or a charge may be levied. Wherever possible, details will be given in the port information on board and by your local guide. It is polite to ask someone before taking their picture and you should refrain from taking photographs of officials in uniform.

SHOPPING

Where possible and when indicated, time for shopping has been allowed within the framework of some of the excursions. We must point out however, these excursions are primarily designed by the local shore excursion agent for the highlights in each port and such free time is generally limited. Shopping opportunities may be further limited if the day of our call falls on a Sunday or a local public

holiday. Please familiarise yourself with Customs Regulations which may stipulate for instance that it is illegal to bring items such as animal furs and skins back into the country.

SMOKING

Smoking is not permitted on excursion coaches.

BOOKING DEADLINE

Please visit the team at Destination Services and they will be delighted to discuss availability and the deadline for the booking of individual excursions and more information on all the ports of call will be advised in the daily programme.

Destination Services hold regular explore ashore talks to give you an insight into each of the ports you will be visiting. We advise you to book your shore excursions as soon as possible when Destination Services opens, complete a simple Booking Form and a Drop Box is provided for use 24 hours a day. Deadline for making a booking is generally 48 hours prior to the date of the individual excursion. After this deadline bookings can only be accepted if there are places available and the team at Destination Services will be happy to advise.

ONBOARD CANCELLATION

Excursions may be cancelled in advance at Destination Services on board up to and including 48 hours' notice and a full refund will be offered. Any excursions cancelled after the 48 hours' notice period will unfortunately not be entitled to a refund. If special events and entrance fees are included in the excursion price and where it is necessary to pay in advance for these events or special services, no refund will be offered and full charges will be made at time of cancellation to cover our costs. In such circumstances

beyond our control for example inclement weather conditions and a cancellation or change of port a full refund will be offered or the opportunity to book an alternative excursion in the new port.

MINIMUM NUMBERS

All excursions operated by our local agents are subject to a minimum number of guests. When an excursion is cancelled due to lack of support a refund will be made to your on-board account.

EXCURSION WAITLISTS

Some shore excursions operated by our local shore excursion agents have limited places. If at the time we receive your booking our local shore excursion agent is not able to accommodate you on any selected excursions, you will be placed on a waitlist and we will endeavour to secure additional places and if our local shore excursion agent is able to accommodate your booking, the tickets will be in your cabin when you embark the ship. Should the local shore excursion agent be unable to accommodate your booking by the time you embark the ship, Destination Services will contact you to discuss alternative excursions that may be of interest to you. Any refund/s due will be posted as a credit to your on-board account.

EXCURSION ITINERARIES

Information is correct at time of going to print. It is possible that due to local conditions on arrival in port, it may be necessary to slightly alter excursion itineraries. The company reserves the right to alter excursion itineraries provided by their local shore excursion agent's or cancel excursions at their discretion. At the discretion of our local shore excursion agent's places of interest might be visited in a different order than that shown in the excursion description.

Occasionally, due to local conditions on the day, places may have to be omitted although whenever possible an alternative visit will be arranged by the local shore excursion agent following liaison with Destination Services on board.

FOREIGN, COMMONWEALTH AND DEVELOPMENT OFFICE ADVICE

Guest safety is of paramount importance, and we follow advice outlined by the Foreign Commonwealth Office, therefore please note that the advertised programme may be changed accordingly.

COVID REGULATIONS

In order to align with up to date COVID regulations and to ensure the safety of our guests and communities: timings, content and capacities will be adjusted as needed. Many venues may have last minute closures and some inclusions, venues, or destinations may be removed or replaced, subject to their availability and local regulations. Should any excursions be cancelled once you have booked, you will be fully refunded for the cost of your excursion.

CONDUCT

If by your conduct you prejudice the enjoyment of an excursion for others, we reserve the right to exclude you from that or any future excursions and to recover compensation from you. No refund of the excursion cost will be available in these circumstances.

OUR PRICING STRUCTURE

All prices are based on operating costs, tariffs and rates of exchange at the time of printing and are subject to change without notice. The excursions

in this guide are operated under the management of responsible and very experienced local shore excursion agents, who we have carefully appointed based on their reputation and competency to ensure we offer comfortable, safe and convenient surroundings.

The information in this booklet represents the plans and intentions of our Company at the time of going to print. Events subsequent to going to print may cause us unavoidably to change our plans, which could affect the published itineraries. Every effort has been made in conjunction with our local shore excursion agents to ensure the accuracy of the information contained within this shore excursion guide; no responsibility can be accepted by our Company for omissions or errors.
